For candidates with post basic B.Sc. in Nursing degree no such experience is needed after graduation.

The aggregated marks obtained be not less than 50%.

**Duration:** Four academic years.

## ATTENDANCE, PROGRESS AND CONDUCT

Each student must have a certificate of satisfactory attendance, progress and conduct by the principal to be eligible for appearance in the university examination.

A minimum of 80% attendance is required in theory and 100% attendance is required in practical classes respectively.

Attendance of 10% may be condoned by the vice chancellor on the recommendation of the principal based on genuinity of the case.

## INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

As per the university guidelines 20% of the marks are set for internal assessment which are considered for the evaluation during the final university examination. Every year a minimum of two assignments and three periodical tests are conducted for each subjects to assess the performance of the candidate.

## DECLARATION OF RESULT

### CRITERIA FOR PASS

Main subjects:

A candidate is declared to have passed the examination in a subject, if she/he secure 50% of the marks in theory and 50% of the marks in practical. Candidates has to secure a minimum of 40% marks in the university conducted written examination and 50% aggregate, i.e., marks scored in the university conducted written examination and assessment (theory) added together and for a pass in practical, a candidate has to secure a minimum of 40% if the marks I university conducted practical examination and internal assessment (practical) are added.

## SUBSIDIARY SUBJECTS

The examination for subsidiary subjects shall be conducted by the respective colleges. For a pass in the subsidiary a candidate should secure 35% of the total marks prescribed for the subjects and has to pass all the subsidiary subjects before appearing for the final year of the university exam.



# TELE MEDICINE

Training for telemedicine is conducted for three months which is included in the nursing curriculum. Separate certificates are issued.
